- contextualize
 - to consider something in its context:
 - We need to contextualize the problem before we can understand its origin
- rigorously
 - in a careful way so that every part of something is looked at or considered to make certain it is correct or safe:
 - The plutonium fuel cells had been rigorously tested.
 - Isabel thinks rigorously and creatively about many different things
- range
 - a set of similar things
 - I offered her a range of options
 - There is a wide/whole range of options on this issue
- novel
 - new and original, not like anything seen before:
 - a novel idea/suggetion
 - Keeping a sheep in the garden is a novel way of keeping the grass short!
