Syntax

```
(*ns*)
```

Example

```
(ns clojure.examples.example
  (:require [clojure.set :as set])
  (:gen-class))
(defn example []
  (println *ns*))
(example)
```

Output

```
#object[clojure.lang.Namespace 0x50ad3bc1 clojure.examples.hello]
```
